2. Bed Romance at Tunnel Tunnel

Tunnel Tunnel is an art gallery located in the centre of Lausanne and conceives projects that are then displayed as conversations, “between the members of the [programming] collective, the artists and the visitors”. It is approach that has been adopted for *Bed Romance*, a new exhibition at the gallery. The two student artists from HEAD, Jérémy Dafflon and Nelson Schaub propose works with strong, saturated colours that plunge us into the intimacy of bed sheets, “territory where narratives with fluid identities unfold, which paint features of fantasized, exaggerated and necessary realities”. The bed, the erotic place par excellence, a place of our intimate questions and our inner torments. Does all this seem mysterious to you? So do we too! We will quickly go to Tunnel Tunnel, because curiosity has suddenly taken hold of us.
